## WebPT Password Changes

On Dec 16<sup>th</sup>, WebPT will implement new security features that will help you to ensure patient data is adequately protected. This change is a proactive step to further protect you and your patients. There has never been a breach of data in WebPT. Starting on Dec 17<sup>th</sup> you will have 6 days to willingly change your password. After the 6 days has passed, beginning on Dec 23<sup>rd</sup>, you will have to change your password to log into WebPT. Don't worry, you will never be 'locked out' of WebPT.

WebPT passwords will now require at least one letter, one number and one special character. An acceptable special character is defined as the following: !, @, #, \$, ^, &, \*, (, ). Below you will find the acceptable characters as they appear on your keyboard. The % symbol will not be accepted.



Ex. Webpt2012# is an acceptable password

WebPT will provide members with a strength meter. If you only meet the minimum security requirements, your password will receive a score of 50%. We encourage you to make your password as secure as possible by adding in upper and lowercase letters and extending the amount of characters. Below you will find the screen that will be presented upon login when passwords are expired.

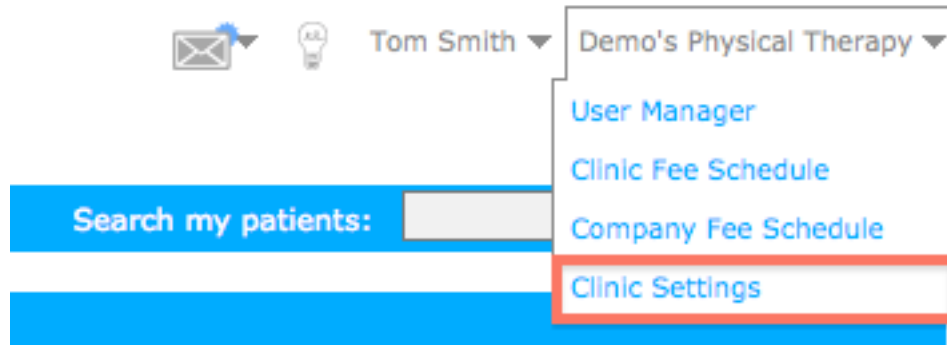
